Saint Oswald's Catholic Primary School, Council Avenue, Ashton In Makerfield, Wigan need to keep some facts that belong to you.

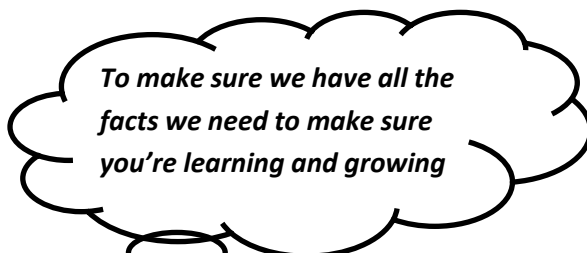
What are facts about you?

Who can see my facts?

The Headteacher, teachers, Local Authority, Department of Education, your family, Ofsted, Bursar, new school, Courts, Police (if requested), NHS, Health and Social Welfare (Safeguarding concerns)

How long do we keep your facts?

We will always keep your facts for as long as you are at the school. If you go to a new school, your facts will be shared with them too.

Other information to remember.

Your parents/carers can ask us to only share your name, address and date of birth and nothing else by sending an email or letter to the school office. When you're 16, it's up to you to decide what information you want to share.
