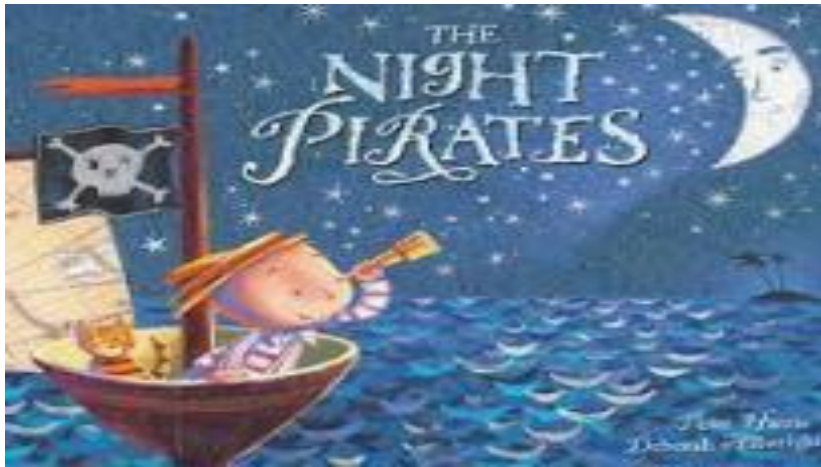


Eaglets Book Blog 2.7.21
