We are Pilgrims of Hope!




We proudly display our banner on the railings at the front of school.

As a school we have raised £1300 for Mkaka Village in Malawi. We have made a new friend in Deacon Justin Malewazi. The children




devise their own competitions with money raised going to Mkaka Village. We also have a Whatsapp group so we can communicate with the children in






Freebie Friday for our whole school community to come and take food, drink, toiletries etc for free.
