Can you make this steady pattern over and over again?

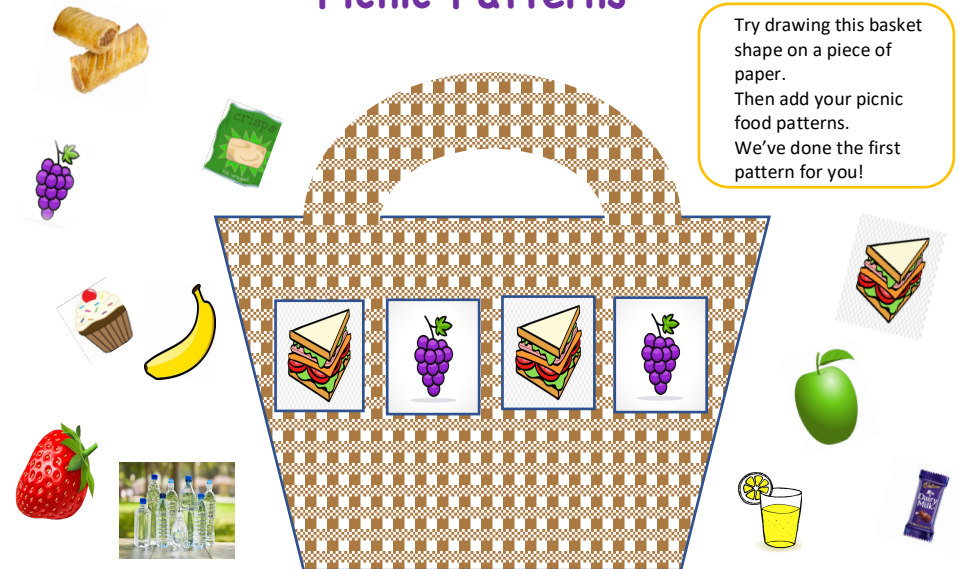
Try this steady pattern whilst saying the words of the rhyme.
