SATs Results

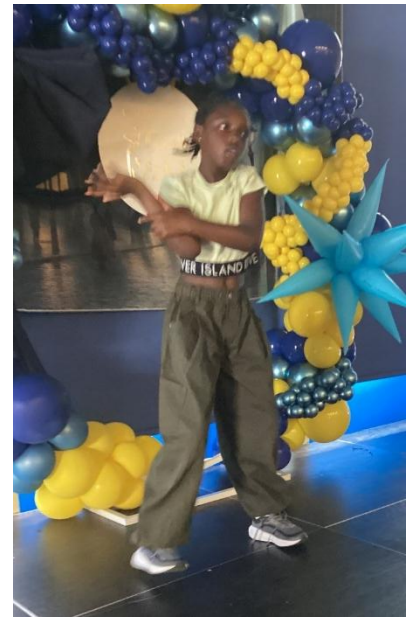

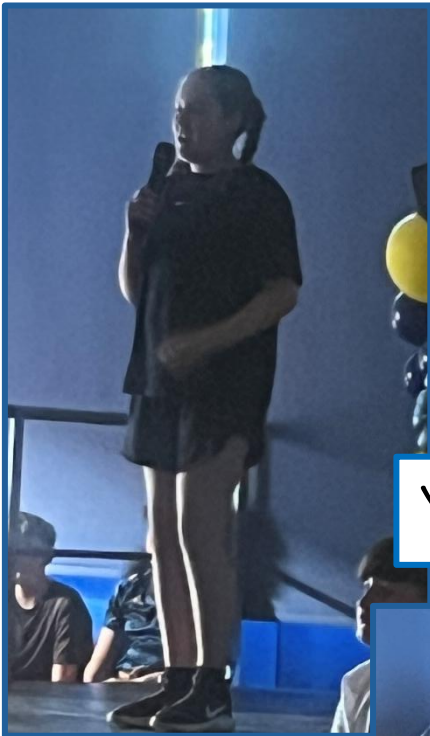
From Little Hands to Big Dreams

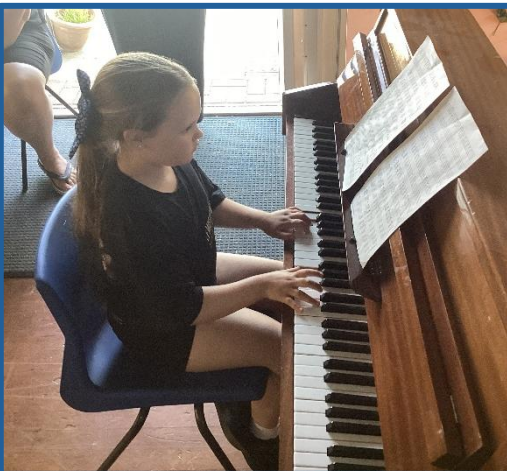
