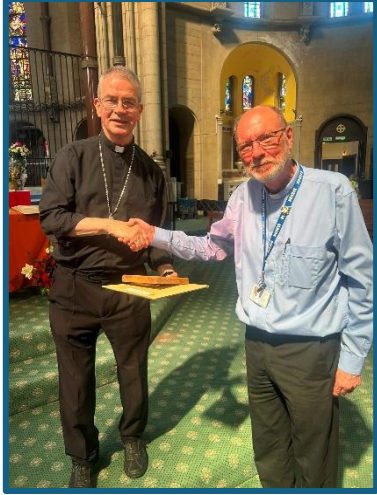
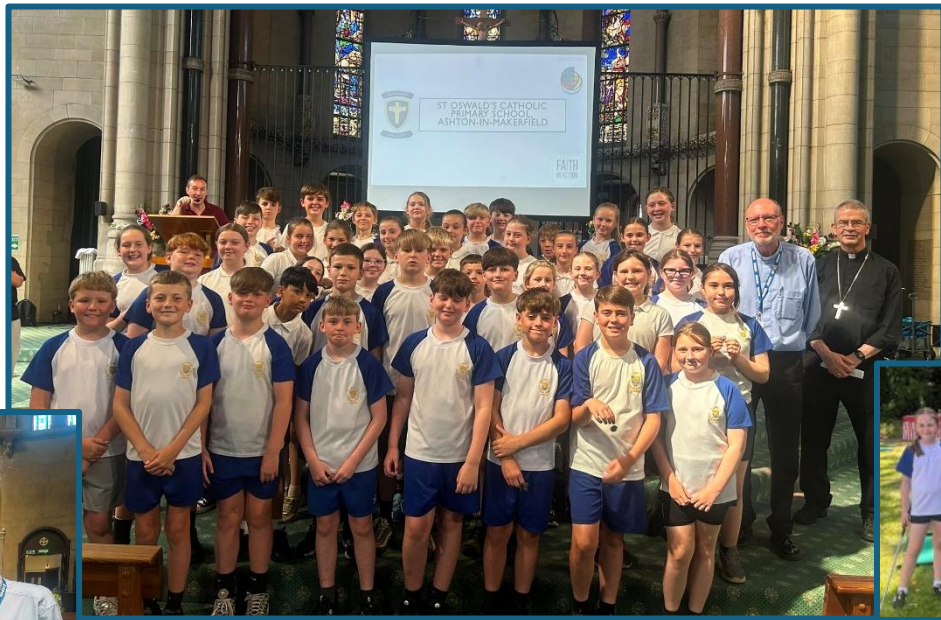
## Ozzie's Got Talent!
