

#### **Coronavirus Update**

The following advice was received from the Archbishop on Friday of this week,

Most of the Archdiocese is now under not just national rulings but also local lockdown regulations. It seems clear that:

#### From <u>NOW</u>:

Home visits should not be taking place, so the permission for visiting with Holy Communion should not be used at the moment.

### From Monday 28th September:

**Baptisms**: There can only be 6 people present (the rule of 6 applies.)

Weddings: There can only be 15 in the Church and for the reception.

**Funerals:** The number remains at 30 (although any reception is now limited to a gathering of 6). As a result, those attending funerals, apart from the immediate family, will be asked to take their seats in Church before the Service begins.

1st Communions: Small groups (not more than 6 people) are allowed to celebrate 1<sup>st</sup> Communions within a special Mass. As the arrangements that we had already made fall within this criteria, the 1st Communion celebrations planned for the next three weeks will go ahead.

**QR Codes**: The new track and trace NHS app asks that places of worship set up a QR bar code and have it on posters around the entrances to churches so that people can use a smart phone to register their presence. Each of our Churches now has its own unique QR code which you will find on posters at the entrance to the Church.

Once again, I would remind you that we are only able to open our Churches at all thanks to the generosity of those who have volunteered to steward and clean the Churches before and after services. They have now been doing so continuously for 3 months. As more people are now coming back to Mass, I would ask you once again to consider whether you can give some time to help in this regard.

## Drainage Works

Work is expected to start this week installing new drains on the Grotto side of the Church. This will, hopefully, much improve the condition of the Church building and of the site as a whole. This will require a section of the path to be closed, so please take care when visiting the Grotto or the cemetery

#### St. Oswald's Cemetery

Further to the introduction of the new Cemetery Regulations, the £30 Maintenance Fee for this year is now due. This can be paid by cash or cheque made payable to 'St. Oswald's Parish' and handed into the Parish Office. Please include the name of the deed-holder and either the Plot number (if known) or details of those interred in the grave.

To assist with the maintenance of the cemetery, there is now a green bin (for **garden waste only**) and a black bin (for all other waste). Please help to improve the appearance of the cemetery by using the correct bin, as you would do at home.
