The Season of Advent


Children are now preparing for the season of Advent in school.

Advent is an important part of the Christian calendar; it is the period leading up to Christmas.

Advent starts on the Sunday nearest to 30 November (3rd December) four weekends before Christmas.

The word 'advent' means 'coming', and Christians reflect on the sacred meaning of Christmas. Despite the secular preparations taking place, e.g., buying presents and going to parties, Advent reminds Christians to remember and prepare for the birth of Jesus. Purple is the usual *liturgical colour* used during Advent in the UK. The colour is often used for hangings around the church and our sacred spaces in school. Some churches have an Advent *wreath* with five candles, one for each of the four Sundays leading up to *Christmas Day* and one for Christmas Day itself. There are different readings on each of the four Sundays leading up to Christmas Day.





Christmas Jumper Day Friday 8th December

Children are invited to wear a Christmas Jumper on the 8th December. 50p suggested donation. All donations will go to Save The Children. It is a non uniform day and the Christmas jumper is optional.
