Easter Sunday—Mass at Holy Rosary, 10am includes Egg Rolling for the children!!

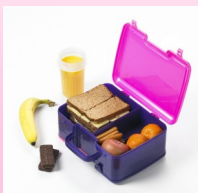


"Peace be with you all" - Pope Leo XIV
