Dear Parents and Carers,

Class 1 will be visiting Hardwick Park on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> July. We will leave school at 9.30am and return for the end of the school day. The purpose of this exciting visit is to support our Science and Geography work. During the day the children will take part in an immersive outdoor educational workshop, 'Summer in Bloom'. Children will have the opportunity to explore, look and wonder at the diversity of nature in the park. They will learn about the life cycle of seeds and the special relationship between minibeast and plants. Towards the end of the day the children will also get a chance to visit the play park.

Children do not need to wear school uniform on this day. However, as most of the activities are outdoors could you please ensure that your child wears suitable clothing and footwear. Weather permitting, they will need both waterproof coat and wellies **or** sunhat and sun cream (please do not send cream into school, apply at home).

Your child will require a packed lunch and plenty of fluids for the day. The cook can provide a packed lunch for those children who normally have a school meal. Please complete the slip below if you would like a school packed lunch indicating which sandwich your child prefers.

The **cost of the visit is £9.33** which covers the cost of transport, the deadline for payment is Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2026. We are very grateful to the **Friends of St Paul's**, who have kindly agreed to subsidise the visit by funding the workshop element. If contributions are not sufficient to cover the cost, we will follow school policy, and the trip would be cancelled, full refunds would be given to those who had paid. In the event of a child missing the visit, for whatever reason, we are unfortunately unable to issue refunds. There will be a payment item added to Arbor.
