We will require a small number of adults to accompany the children. If you can help, please email office@stpauls.bhcet.org.uk. Unfortunately, spaces for adults are limited, so please don't be disappointed if we are unable to take up your offer. We will confirm arrangements as soon as possible.

Please note:

- The children will attend an **afternoon performance** and will return to school at approximately **4:00pm**.
- There will be **no Multi-Sports Club** on this date; payments already made will be carried forward to next term.
- If you need Wraparound Care, please book for the **4:15–5:15/5:30 session**.

Additional Information:

- Children should wear **full winter uniform**.
- They will leave school at around **12 noon**, after having lunch at school.
- On return, children will be dismissed as normal at **4:00pm**. Please allow staff to take children back into school to collect belongings. It will not be possible to collect them directly from the bus.
- There will be **no crossing patrol** at this time.
