Year 5 Curriculum – Relationships and Sex Education Lessons

Our Year 5 Science unit of work next half term is 'Changes and Reproduction'. As part of this unit, the children will learn about the changes that occur in the human body as they grow older, including puberty. They will also explore the life processes of reproduction in some plants and animals. This unit supports the requirement for all schools to teach high-quality Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) in PSHE, alongside the statutory requirements of the Science National Curriculum.

The children have already started to explore plant reproduction in their science lessons. Next half term, they will move on to learning about reproduction in animals, including humans. Before these lessons take place, we would like to give you the opportunity to view the materials that will be used and discuss how we will approach this subject.
