Year 2 will be visiting The Captain Cook Birthplace Museum in Stewart Park on Wednesday 18th June 2025. We will leave school at 9.15am and return in time for the end of the school day. The purpose of this exciting visit is to support our history and science work. During the day the children will take part in a workshop entitled 'Captain Cook: a Significant Local Individual from the Past' in which they will take a guided journey through the galleries and experience the life and legacy of Captain James Cook. They will then use this new knowledge in an exciting afternoon of craft activities.

Children do not need to wear school uniform on this day. However, as some time will be spent outdoors could you please ensure that your child wears suitable clothing and footwear. They will need a waterproof coat and / or sunhat and sun cream (please do not send cream into school, apply at home).

A voluntary contribution of £12.50 per child towards the cost of the trip would be appreciated. Payments can be made by logging onto your MCAS (My Child at School) account. If contributions are not sufficient to cover the cost of this visit then we will follow school policy and the event will be cancelled. Full refunds will be given to children who have paid.
