Dear Parents and Carers,

A visit to Tweddle Farm, Hartlepool has been organised for Nursery and Reception on Tuesday 10th June linked to our science and topic work surrounding new life, animals and our wider environment. The trip will provide pupils with a rich experience of farm life and an understanding of caring for animals guided by their expert educational staff in the local area, alongside sharing an enjoyable day out with friends.

The children will leave school at approximately 9.15am and we will be arriving back at school for the end of the school day.

The children will require a packed lunch, please include an extra drink. Our school cook can offer a packed lunch for those children who normally take school meals. Please email office@stpauls.bhcet.org.uk or complete the slip below if you would like a school packed lunch, indicating which sandwiches your child would prefer.

We do understand that this is an expensive trip as the transport is so costly due to coach prices, but we hope that it will be worthwhile for the children. A voluntary contribution of £17.25 per child will cover the cost of admission and transport. Payments can be made by logging onto your My Child at School (MCAS) account. If contributions are not sufficient to cover the cost of this visit then we will follow school policy and the event will be cancelled. Full refunds will be given to children who have paid. In the event of a child missing the visit, for whatever reason, we are unfortunately unable to offer refunds.

Generic consent forms were completed at the start of September/start of nursery to cover this visit.

Children may wear their own clothes for the visit, however, please take into account the unpredictable weather. Children must have sun cream, sun hat, suitable footwear and a rain coat.
