Dear Parents and Carers

I hope this letter finds you well.

I would like to share some dates with you which you may find useful to have advance notice of. A whole school newsletter will be coming out shortly, but I understand that having these dates sooner rather than later will be helpful.

Whole school photograph shoot:

The Trust has organised for professional photographers visit our school during the afternoon of next **Monday 2**nd **October.** The photographer will be taking photos of 'school life' to include on our new website and any brochures which may be used to promote school events. Please can your child be dressed in their 'winter uniform' (shirt and tie) for this event. (PE uniform worn as usual for Y1 please and any children doing multi-sports after-school).

Class Liturgical Prayer time:

Liturgical prayer takes place each day in school, either in the classroom, with a group of classes, or as a whole school gathering. Liturgical prayer is an opportunity for us to gather, listen to the Word (which comes from scripture), to respond to the Word and to go forth with a mission. Liturgical prayer is a short opportunity each day to thank and praise God. Liturgical prayer is not a 'performance' or a well-rehearsed event, but simply an opportunity to take part in a prayerful part of our school day.

Parents, carers and families are warmly invited to join your child's class for liturgical prayer on the following dates:

Thursday 5th October – Y5, Thursday 12th October – Y2, Friday 13th October – Y3, Monday 16th October – Y4, Tuesday 17th October – Y6, Friday 10th November – Y1

Please come to the main school entrance at 2.45pm* Liturgical prayer will begin at 2.50pm and will last 10-15 minutes. If you can't make this occasion, there will be another opportunity during the Spring term.

Wednesday 18th October – Reception Class Welcome Liturgy *2.15pm followed by refreshments
