End of Year Expect ations	Children at the expected level of development will:  • read all Set 1 sounds.  • say a sound for each letter in the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs  • Read words consistent with their phonic knowledge by sound-blending  • Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.	Children can read all Set 1, 2, 3 sounds in words and can read Set 1 and 2 sounds in words at speed. They can read some Set3 sounds and additional sounds in words without hesitation.  They can read at a pace of 60 words per minute.
