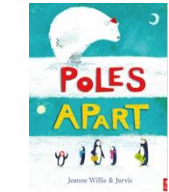


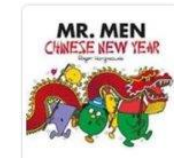
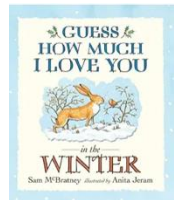


Spring 1 Learning Journey: Reception

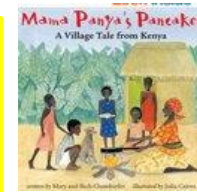


- To know where to find the polar regions on a world map

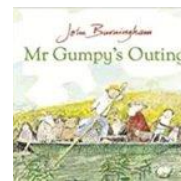

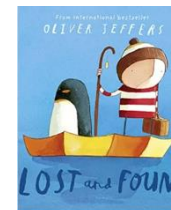


- What do we use a church for (RE).
