

Dear Parents,

Thank you for supporting your child as they prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation in December, and Holy Communion next year.

The second preparation session takes place this coming Thursday 14th November, straight after school. Please join us again for a short Liturgy at the end of the session (4.15pm) by coming into school, via the Thames Road entrance and straight up the path towards the Year 4 classroom.

Fr Adrian has asked me to remind you about the importance of bringing your child to Mass, especially the weekend following the school session, as the children will be invited to take part in a particular part of the Mass. This is a very important way that home, school and our parish work together to support your child's spiritual journey.

At the end of Mass this weekend, Fr Adrian has asked for parents to stay behind for 10 minutes so that he can speak to you.
