- Please all gather on the school field, the children will warm up together and then split into teams.
- When you arrive on the field you will notice that the field will be set up with equipment, please if you are bringing small children can you ensure that none of the equipment is moved.
- Unfortunately, we are unable to provide seating, but you are welcome to bring your own deckchairs and rugs.
- When Sports Day is finished, please can you let your child go back to the EYFS garden with their teacher and we will quickly let children come home from their usual exits.
