Dear Parents and Carers,

On Wednesday 19th February Year 3 will be going to Teesmouth Field Centre to enhance their learning in Geography and our Rivers topic. The day will begin with classroom-based activities, focusing on the River Tees from the source to the mouth, looking at river features such as waterfalls, meanders and tributaries along its course. The children will then visit the transporter bridge and North Gare Beach to see the river mouth and build models of the river, from source to mouth. This is a fantastic experience to practically explore what they have been learning about during class lessons.

A voluntary contribution of £11.63 towards the cost of the bus and trip would be appreciated, the deadline for payment is Friday 7th February 2025. If contributions are not sufficient to cover the cost, we will follow school policy, and the trip would be cancelled, full refunds would be given to those who had paid.
