What is a Young Carer?

If you are under 18 and help to look after a relative or family member with a disability, illness, mental health condition or substance abuse problem.

What might a young carer do?

- Practical tasks, like cooking, housework and shopping.
- Physical care, such as helping someone out of bed.
- Emotional support, including talking to someone who is distressed.
- Personal care, such as helping someone dress.
- Managing the family budget and collecting prescriptions.
- Helping to give medicine.
- Helping someone communicate.
- Looking after brothers and sisters.
