Pupils	<p>At our school we expect children to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be respectful and take responsibility for their behaviour in and out of school. • Be ready e.g. come to school ready for the day, in the right uniform, on time and with a positive attitude for school life and learning. • Be safe and ensure everyone is treated with kindness and courteous behaviour e.g. demonstrating good manners. • Read daily and hand in homework on time, to a high standard. • Use online technologies in school and at home safely, sensibly and respectfully and only with permission from a trusted adult.
Parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure your child(ren) are in school consistently and on time (maintain over 95% attendance). • Follow the school’s policies on absence reporting (contacting school before 8.30am on every day of absence) and requesting time off school during term time at least 2 weeks in advance. • Ensure your child is in the correct school uniform and that PE kits, musical instruments and appropriate equipment are in school on timetabled days. • Support the school to maintain high standards of behaviour (Be Safe, Be Respectful and Be Ready). • Update the school office if there are changes to pick up / collection arrangements. • Update the school office with any changes to family circumstances, address, contact and / or medical details and anything that may affect your child’s learning, wellbeing or behaviour. • Contact school if you have concerns or issues and do not post issues on social media, messaging platforms or challenge other parents when things are being dealt with by school. • Keep content in parental WhatsApp groups respectful towards school, staff, other parents and children. • Regularly check your child for headlice and inform school when they are being treated. • If travelling by car, ensure you park sensibly, safely and respectfully.
<p>Reading and Homework</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Read daily with your child and discuss their book and vocabulary. 2) Support your child with any homework. Please be aware that this increases as your child moves through school and it is expected that it is completed on time. 3) Use the communication diary to record when work has been carried out at home in a concise way that enables transparency between home and school. 	<p>Behaviour, uniform, jewellery, hair and make up</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Support the school’s behaviour policy and consequences used. 2) Ensure your child is wearing the correct uniform and PE kit, ensuring all items are named. 3) Understand that children will be expected to wear spare uniform if they are wearing incorrect items. 4) Understand that children will be asked to remove make up, jewellery and change any inappropriate hair cuts or excessive hair accessories.
