Children's Individuality is Celebrated

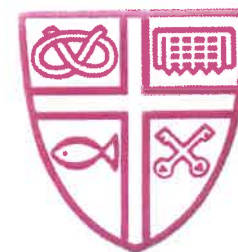
Children have many opportunities to shine whether they are good at art, music or sport. We celebrate all success together.
