Mission Statement:

- Planning in a range of experiences that enrich the curriculum and provide opportunities for pupils to explore their capabilities and show off their talents including: Standon Bowers, Musical evenings, Plays and performances, be part of sports teams or involved in whole school challenges.
- Setting work that challenges children ensuring that they make great progress from their starting points.
- Consistently providing high quality teaching targeted to meet the individual needs of all children through using inspirational teaching strategies, quality resources, focused questions, effective assessment
- Teaching the children the skills need to be effective learners, modelling learning skills and giving the children opportunities to practice those skills.

- Promoting independence, British values, economic well-being, an awareness of new technologies ensuring that children are prepared for life after education.
- Supporting the children to take part in charitable acts that help the local community as well as communities throughout the World.
