## Tesco Blue Counters

One of our parents has applied on our behalf to Tesco Stronger Starts and been successful. Our project will be put forward to a customer vote in Tesco stores. Voting will commence in store from the first week in October 2024 until Mid January 2025. Our project is to develop our wooded outdoor area as Forest Schools enhances children's development by fostering creativity, independence, a love for nature through outdoor exploration and immersive outdoor activities.

## Class Dojo

Our trial last year of Class Dojo was a success and parents gave positive feedback about the App. So this year we have developed a clear strategy about how we will use it which will be in a number of ways.

Firstly, we will add all upcoming events with reminders to the whole school or class specific calendar. Secondly, we will send messages for the whole school of from class teachers to specific classes or just individual children. Keep an eye out for the red notification on the message tab.

Additionally, Children will gain positive points for completing task or activities such as read 5 times a week or scored better on a test. Parents will be notified that children have won the points.

We will continue to develop how it is used as we become more fluent with the programme. We know children can upload photos of activities at home which we would love to see. Homework can also be set using the programme.
