## ST PETER'S CE(A) PRIMARY SCHOOL

## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

- The name of the school is St Peter's CE (Aided) Primary School, Caverswall.
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Peter's CE (A) Primary School."
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. Chair of Governors (Vicar ex officio)
  - b. 2 parent governors.
  - c. 1 LA governor.
  - d. 2 teacher governors (including Headteacher)
  - e. 7 Foundation governors, of whom 3 shall, at the time of their appointment, be eligible for election or appointment as parent governors.
  - f. 1 sponsor governor
- 5. Total number of governors 14 (8 foundation governors)
- 1 Foundation Governor shall be appointed by the Bishop of Lichfield
  - 4 Foundation Governors shall be appointed by the Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education
  - 3 Foundation Governors shall be appointed by the Parochial Church Council for St Peter's Church Caverswall
- 7. a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-office:

  Rev Steven Osbourne Vicar of the Parish of Caverswall.
  - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated will appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23 (2) of the Regulations.

- 8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 9. The school has a Trust Deed.
- 10. The school has a religious character and ethos in accordance with the tenets and beliefs of the Church of England.
- 11. The term of office for all governors is four years.
- 12. The instrument of government comes into effect on 1 September 2008.
- 13. This instrument was made by order of Staffordshire LA.
- 14. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education.
