

ST PETER'S CE(A) PRIMARY SCHOOL

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is St Peter's CE (Aided) Primary School, Caverswall.
2. The school is a voluntary aided school.
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St Peter's CE (A) Primary School."
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. Chair of Governors (Vicar - ex officio)
 - b. 2 parent governors.
 - c. 1 LA governor.
 - d. 2 teacher governors (including Headteacher)
 - e. 7 Foundation governors, of whom 3 shall, at the time of their appointment, be eligible for election or appointment as parent governors.
 - f. 1 sponsor governor
5. Total number of governors 14 (8 foundation governors)
6. 1 Foundation Governor shall be appointed by the Bishop of Lichfield
 - 4 Foundation Governors shall be appointed by the Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education
 - 3 Foundation Governors shall be appointed by the Parochial Church Council for St Peter's Church Caverswall
7.
 - a. The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-office :
Rev Steven Osbourne Vicar of the Parish of Caverswall.
 - b. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated will appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex-officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23 (2) of the Regulations.

8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated is entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. The school has a Trust Deed.
10. The school has a religious character and ethos in accordance with the tenets and beliefs of the Church of England.
11. The term of office for all governors is four years.
12. The instrument of government comes into effect on 1 September 2008.
13. This instrument was made by order of Staffordshire LA.
14. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governor body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the Lichfield Diocesan Board of Education.
