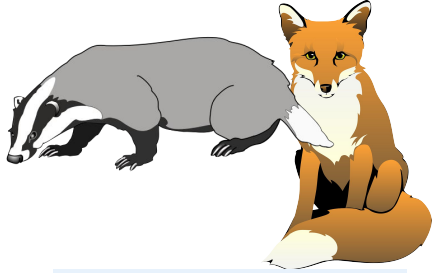


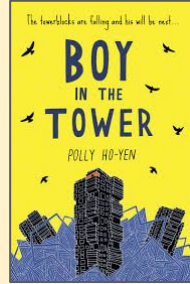


Year 5 Spring Curriculum Newsletter
