Maths-

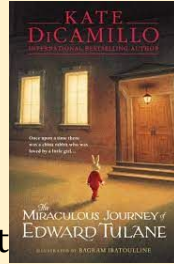
We are focusing on the times tables check that will be happening at the beginning of June.
