Maths:

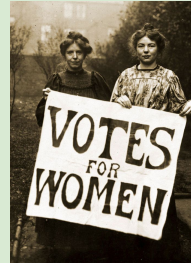
This term, we will be focusing on factors, prime numbers and multiples using BIDMAS before moving onto fractions and decimals.

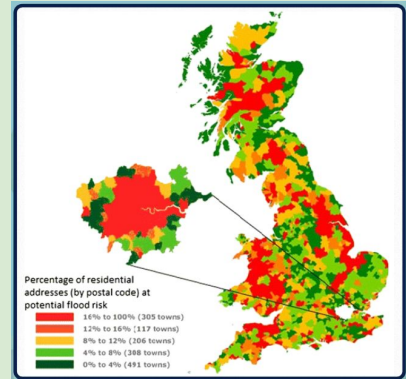
History
