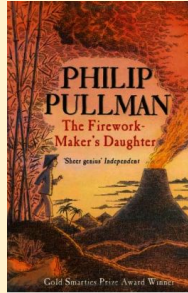


Year 3 Spring Curriculum Newsletter



Complete Mathematics

English

We are closely reading Philip Pullman's, 'The Firework Maker's Daughter.' Our writing will focus on biographies of the author, instructions and narratives, inspired by the story. The writers will learn to use a variety of sentence types in their writing.

History

Anglo-Saxons, Picts and Scots

The children will be learning about Anglo-Saxon settlements, culture and religion as well as developing an understanding of the impact of key historical figures like Alfred the Great.



Geography

In Geography, the children will be Comparing local rivers to other rivers in Europe and Africa.
