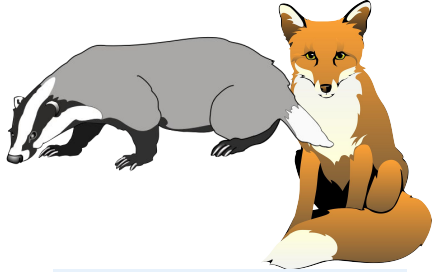
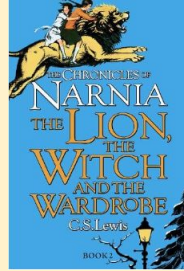


Year 5 Spring Curriculum Newsletter



Complete Mathematics

Children will study these areas of the UK and the part they have played in UK history from the draining of the Fens to the Industrial Revolution.

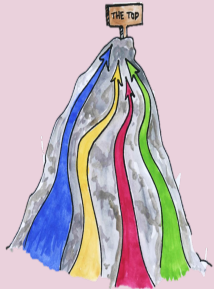




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RE **Hinduism**
