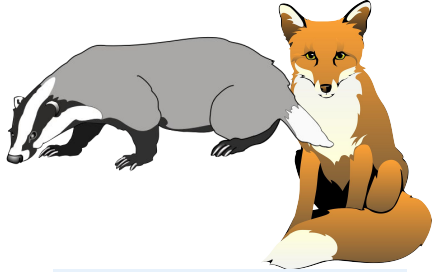
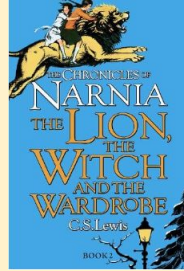


Year 5 Spring Curriculum Newsletter



Complete Mathematics

Maths- We will focus on fractions, decimals and percentages this half-term. We will be converting between all three, solving a variety of fraction, percentage and decimal problems and learning new methods to help with this.



English

We are closely reading the classic; The Lion, the witch and the wardrobe. Our writing will focus on an exciting narrative story, based through a portal. We are getting close to the climax of our book and are very excited!

History The Transatlantic Slave Trade.

This half term the children will be learning about the Transatlantic Slave Trade and how people were traded for different goods. We will then look at how it was abolished and how this helped to change human rights.

Geography Australia

Children will study Australia: how it was discovered, the human and physical features, as well as how it went from being populated by Aboriginal people, to being part of the Commonwealth.

RE

This half-term we will focus on how we can think critically in RE to better understand the subject. We will then begin our new unit where we can apply these thinking skills to our learning about different religions.

SCIENCE Forces

Children will be looking at what forces are, who discovered and researched them, how they impact different objects and how we manipulate forces to create machines, or keep people safe when driving.



Computing:

Learners will develop their knowledge of 'selection' by revisiting how 'conditions' can be used in programming.

Children will focus on art from China. We will be looking at calligraphy and how Chinese art is painted and drawn using different tools and on different materials.



PSHE Drugs

Children will learn about drugs, smoking and alcohol and the negative impacts they have on the body.
