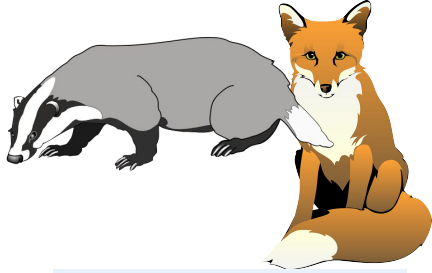
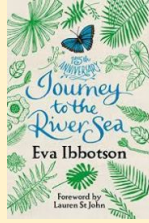


Year 5 Summer Curriculum Newsletter

ENGLISH

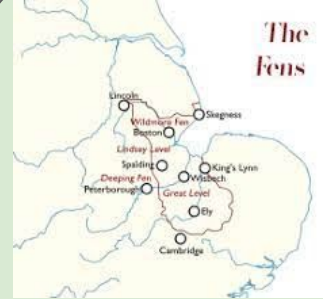
