Pupils should bring an item of non-perishable food to donate to the Food Bank or a £2 donation. More information to follow after the half term break.




The Art of Maths Workshop:

Children are invited to come to school dressed up as their favourite character, or non-uniform if you prefer not to. We can't wait to see your fantastic costumes!




Story in a Jar Competition:
