All children will sit for an individual photo during the day.

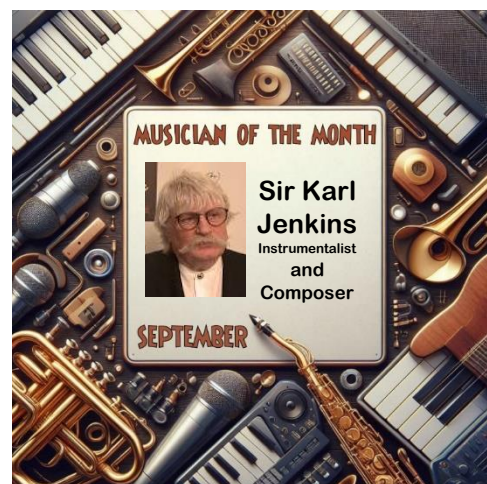
If you would like your siblings to be photographed together, please come along to school between 8am-9.15am and head to the school hall.
