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Dear Parents and Carers,

In the last few weeks of term, year 6 will be looking at Relationship and Sex Education. This topic builds on children's knowledge of how we grow and change, both physically and emotionally, and the types of relationships that people have. Children will learn about sexual relationships and sexually transmitted diseases. They will also learn about positive body images and stereotypes.

Children will be learning about reproductive body parts and naming these and physical and emotional changes that happen in puberty including menstruation. They will look at how to maintain good hygiene and acceptable and unacceptable touch and know what to do if they feel unsafe. They will look at different types of relationships and family structures. They will learn about human reproduction and how babies are conceived.

As a school, we understand that some of these topics may be sensitive and we cover them with sensitivity and respect. If you would like any more information on what is covered in the lesson please just ask and we can provide you with an overview. As a parent / carer, you have the right to withdraw your child from these lessons if you wish.
