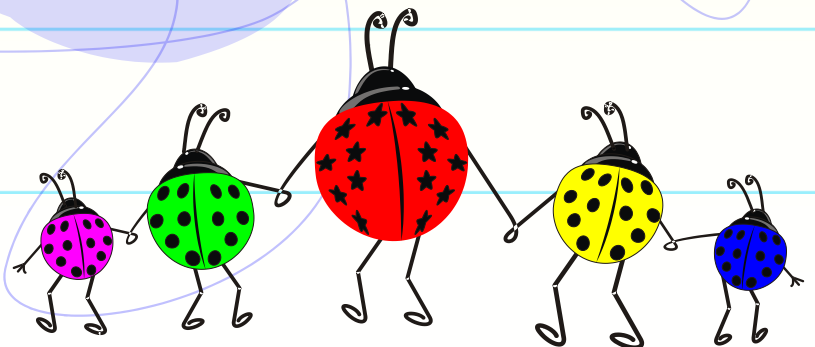

Welcome to Preschool




Preschool sessions are:

When your child starts Preschool you are welcome to come inside and help them find their peg and drawer and help settle them in.

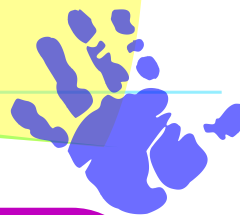
Please help them with the self registration board outside. Your child can find their photograph and put it on the magnetic board to show us they are here.

We love messy play and outdoor learning so please come in old clothes. We do have Preschool Jackets which you can purchase to save your own clothes getting dirty.

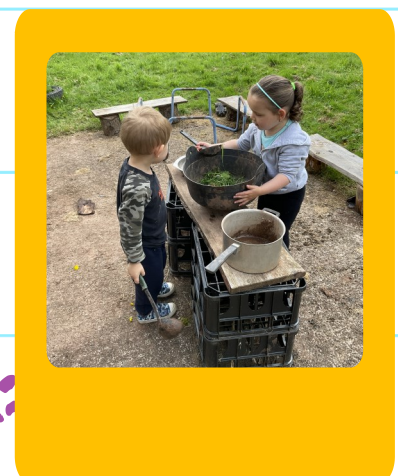


What Will You Need?

Outdoor learning is a huge part of our Preschool. We have some wonderful areas to explore; our playground, the secret garden and forest school. Your child will need appropriate clothing for weather each day. We have waterproof suits in school but please do make sure that they have their own wellies, clearly named and that they always have a coat in school. During the summer they will need their sun hats and sun cream should be applied at home before the school day.



All children need to bring a water bottle to use throughout the day. Children staying all day or attending the morning session will have their lunch at 11.30am. Please bring a packed lunch from home. The school provide fruit and milk every morning. During the afternoon we also provide a fruit snack but this could also be something made by the Preschool Cooking Club. Please advise us of any allergies.

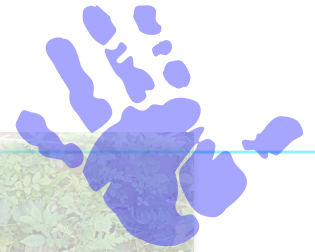
