### News:

As ever, we do encourage families to park (maybe on Winslow Road) and walk along Bramley Orchards or Cherry Tree Close to school where possible so that school and Cherry Tree Close do not become congested. We have recently had complaints from our neighbours, about cars blocking their driveways, parking on the zig-zags and leaving their engines running, causing excess pollution. The last thing we want to do is upset our neighbours and/or cause the Highways Agency to put double yellow lines on the roads surrounding school, so please do be considerate.

### Adventure Playground:

Adventure playgrounds not to be used on the way home please. There is a large sign and the rule is there for good reason! Adventure playgrounds are closed at all times out of school hours and children must not be allowed on them under any circumstances unless one of our staff is officially present. Parents are not authorised to supervise children to play on the adventure play equipment at the end of the day.

### Dogs:

A big thank you to all our families who keep their dogs safely on a lead when arriving on the school grounds. Unfortunately, however, we have had numerous incidences of dogs fouling on our school site. It would sadden us to have to reconsider safe pet access onto school grounds so we ask all dog owners to be extra vigilant. Picking up after your dog is of paramount importance for the safety of our children whilst they are working outside.

### Morning snacks:

Reminder – children in year 3, 4, 5 and 6, only healthy snacks are allowed to be eaten at morning playtime, eg. a piece of fruit, vegetable or a cereal bar.

The School Fruit and Vegetable Scheme (SFVS) provides a free piece of fruit or veg to every child in nursery, reception, year 1 and 2.
