



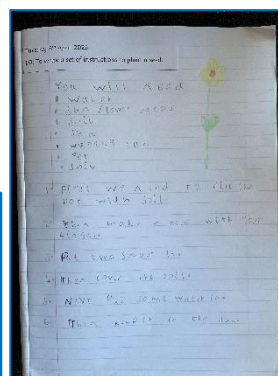
## Newsletter: 11<sup>th</sup> April 2025

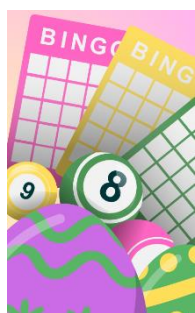
