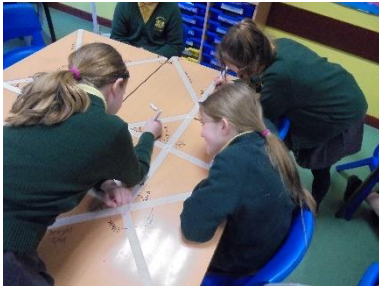




## Newsletter: 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024

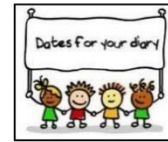

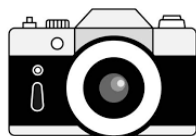
