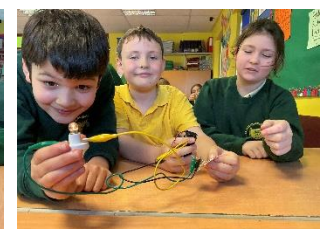
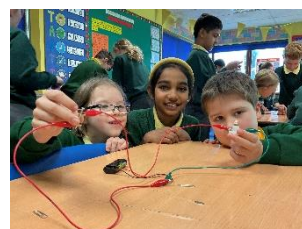
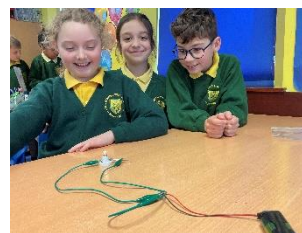


Nursery went on a Stick Man hunt this week - our Story Launch is The Stick Man.
