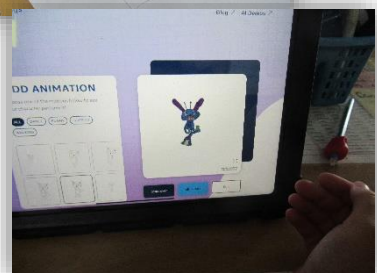

## Here for Herefordshire Holidays (HAF) Programme

Exciting activities for Herefordshire children who are eligible for benefit related free school meals this summer! The programme is running from Monday 28th July to Friday 22nd August. If you are a parent or carer of a school aged child 5 to 16 years old (Reception to year 11) who is eligible for benefits-related free school meals, you can book up to 16 sessions of free activities. Your child/young person will also receive a free nutritious meal during each session.

The 'Here for Herefordshire Holidays' programme which is funded by the Department for Education aims to get young people involved with new, fun activities. There is a wide range of activities on offer across the county, these include coding, farm days, football, theatre, cheerleading, dance, circus skills, bush craft, pony days, gym classes, swimming and more.

Places can be booked for eligible children from Tuesday 1st July at midday: Here for Herefordshire Holidays Programme - Talk Community Directory Places are limited and will be allocated on a 'first come first served' basis. We understand children aren't always able to attend booked activities, however, we would kindly request that if your child is unable to attend, you cancel their session via the booking system to enable others to book on.
