Welcome to Year 6! It has been so lovely to welcome the children into their new classroom and to begin the start of their final year of primary school together. We are so looking forward to a year of hard work, achievement and most of all, fun!

Some Important Information

- **Mrs Makins** will be teaching from Monday to Wednesday.
- **Mrs Nash** will be teaching on a Thursday.
- **Mrs Yarnold** will be teaching on a Friday morning, with **Mrs Miles** teaching on a Friday afternoon.
- **PE** is on a **Monday afternoon**. Children must get changed for PE in school, and will therefore need to ensure they have their kit with them. PE kit consists of:
 - A plain white t-shirt
 - Black or dark blue shorts, leggings or joggers
 - Trainers suitable for outdoor PE
- **Reading** should be happening every day at home – it has been lovely to see so many children writing comments in their reading records to tell us about the book they are reading, please keep this up! Reading records are checked daily, so please make sure they are in school.
- **Spellings** are set on a **Friday** and tested the **following Friday**. Children will come home with a red spelling book containing their spellings to learn.
- **Walking home** – In Year 6, we do allow children to walk home by themselves. If you would like for your child to walk home, please return the consent form on the letter sent home with your child on Wednesday.
- **Mobile Phones** – These shouldn't be brought to school. If there is a reason why you would like your child to bring their phone with them, please contact Mrs Yarnold, Mrs Nash or Mrs Makins.
- **Homework** – Every Tuesday, your child will bring home an arithmetic paper to complete and return on the following Tuesday. This will help them in their preparation for SATs in May and will ensure that they feel confident. Please encourage the children to do these by themselves. If they are finding a question tricky, ask them to put a circle around it so that we can go over it with them.
