Dear parents and carers of pupils in Year 6,



I hope that you all had a lovely break and the Year 6 pupils are ready for the demands of the Summer Term ahead. This is a very important term for Year 6 pupils in so many ways and I want to ensure that we support and prepare the pupils for their transition through the Summer Term and through to their preparations for High School.

With that in mind, I am delighted to welcome back Mrs Hannah Makins who returns this week from her maternity leave. Mrs Makins will join Miss Chambers and Mrs Miles in Year 6 for 3 days per week (Mon-Weds). How can you help?

There are lots of fabulous SATS-related sites online should your child want to do any further revision or learning at home. These include BBC Bitesize for KS2 SATs; CGP books for KS2 SATs which can be ordered online and many fantastic clips on YouTube. All pupils have been given a Maths and Grammar Revision Booklet – reading and learning these is the best way to be ready for the tests ahead. The most important thing is to ensure that the build-up to SATs is calm and stress-free, encouraging our wonderful youngsters to do their best. SATs WEEK is the week beginning Monday 11th May.
