<u>The first son</u>

How did he feel? Do you think that was easy? Give reasons. Have you ever done something like this? When? Why?

The second son

What did the second son choose? Why do you think he changed his mind? How do you think he felt? Have you ever done something like this? When? Why?

The father

How do you think the father felt about his two sons? Why did the father react like this?
