

#### Reading:

- Read Billy's Bucket By Kes Gray. Look closely at the pages when Billy visits Buckets are us. Look at
  the different types of buckets. Draw your own bucket. Draw and make a list of the different types
  of fish you can see in your bucket.
- Read facts about Fish. See attached Document. Can you draw and label the parts of a fish? E. g. fins, gills etc...
- Remember the Bug Club reading scheme. There are lots of lovely books for you to read!

## **Phonics:**

Each day please also complete handwriting practise and phonics activities.

Handwriting: Throughout this week please practise all 'ladder letters': I, i, t, u, j, y. You need to write each letter lots of times to practise it. Make sure you start and finish the letter in the correct place.

- How many words can you find beginning with the letter 'm'?
- Say the alphabet to an adult or sister or brother. Now say these letters Remember, these letters are not in order!

# <u>Topic – Under the sea</u>

- Learn songs and rhymes about fish and the sea and buckets! E.g. There's a hole in my bucket. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 once I caught a fish alive! Jack and Jill.
- Art and Craft activities





#### Picture 1.

- 2. Using coloured paper cut out the shape of a fish.
- 3. Cut through the fish 4 or 5 times, making wavy lines.
- 4. Expand to make your fish bigger, but not losing the shape of the fish.

#### Picture 2.

- 1. Using a paper plate or a piece of cardboard cut out the basic shape of a fish. Have lots of different coloured and patterned shapes cut out ready to stick on.
- 2. Glue the circles on remembering to overlap them to look like fish scales.
- 3. Draw or stick on an eye.
- ❖ Talk about the different things that Billy saw in his bucket. With an adult discuss things that you would find in your bucket. Can you draw and label the fish and underwater creatures in your bucket?
