

Our Topic this half term is Under the sea

Reading:

- Read The Storm Whale.
- Read facts about Whales. Can you draw and label the parts of a whale? Can you create a fact file about Whales.
- Remember the Bug Club reading scheme. There are lots of lovely books for you to read!
- Write down your favourite part of the story.

Phonics:


Each day please also complete handwriting practise and phonics activities.

Handwriting: Throughout this week please practise all letters of the alphabet. You need to write each letter lots of times to practise it. Make sure you start and finish the letter in the correct place.

- How many words can you find beginning with the letter 'g'?
- Phonics: Use the 'Phonics Play' website you can access free games for your children. We are working on phase 2 and 3 in school. The website is: https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/ but it can also be accessed by typing 'phonics play' into Google. On YouTube, Mr Thorne does phonics is another particularly good website. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize offers a variety of phonics and literacy activities.

Writing:

Over the next three weeks we will be reading The Storm Whale. Please follow the link below.

 Without showing the children any of the book, including the cover, or sharing the title, read aloud the first sentence. Using pastels or drawing pencils, ask them to draw what they see in their mind, to illustrate the sentence.

- Read the first two pages (of text) from the book, emphasizing how Noi is left alone all day. Talk about what kinds of things Noi might be doing all day. Discuss what kinds of things his father might be doing all day. Children will role play acting out what the characters may be doing/saying.
- Read the first two pages of the text with children again. Talk about how children may find it fun to plan what food they would eat through the day. Children will choose what they would have for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Re-read the beginning of the text. Discuss how Noi would need to find ways to occupy
 his time all day. Explain that they are going to make a sea-themed game for Noi to play.
 Generate ideas of things that may happen in the game. Ex: You've made friends with a
 mermaid, move ahead 3 spaces.
- Create your own game for Noi to play.
