Phonics:

Handwriting: Throughout this week please practise all letters of the alphabet. You need to write each letter lots of times to practise it. Make sure you start and finish the letter in the correct place.

- Phonics: Use the 'Phonics Play' website you can access free games for your children. We are working on phase 2 and 3 in school. Writing:

Over the next three weeks we will be reading The Storm Whale. Please follow the link below.



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- As a class, look at large pictures of Noi and his father on the screen. Have children discuss what the characters look like, recording specific features. Then encourage children to suggest what the characters may be thinking or feeling, recording these ideas also.
- Without sharing the illustration, read aloud 'One night a great storm raged around their house.' Ask children what it might look like if a storm was happening by the sea.

Brainstorm a list of ideas of things that might be seen/might be happening. Their actual art, or photos of their art will be put in their Literacy Books.

- Inspired by their storm photos, write a poem about the storm and illustrate it.
- Perform you poem to your family.
- Write a diary entry about the day Noi found the whale.
