Reading:

Handwriting: Throughout this week please practise all letters of the alphabet. You need to write each letter lots of times to practise it. Make sure you start and finish the letter in the correct place.

- How many words can you find beginning with the letter 'h'?

Writing:

- Discuss the features of the story: setting, characters, beginning, middle and end. What is the difference between characters and the main character? Can you write about the difference between the characters in the story.
- Create a set of instructions to teach people how to look after a pet (rainbow) fish.
- Write a story about a different 'rainbow' animal, e.g. a Rainbow Bird, a Rainbow Butterfly or a Rainbow Chameleon. What might happen to them?
- Can you write a book review of this story to tell others your opinion about it?
- Can you pretend to be the Rainbow fish and can you draw and write about the ocean and what it is like to live under the sea.
